

## SPARKLING

### N/V Lunetta Prosecco, Veneto, Italy 48

Fragrant, with enticing aromas of apple and peach. Refreshing, dry and harmonious, with crisp fruit flavors and a clean finish. Pale straw in color with greenish reflections, fine bubbles, and a creamy white foam.

### 2021 Fiorini "Becco Rosso" Lambrusco, Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Italy 52

Served chilled, this sparkling red wine from Italy retains just a hint of residual sugar, leaving it tart and dry, with flavors of violets, raspberries, and sour summer cherries.

### N/V Ferrari "Metodo Classico" Brut, Trentodoc, Italy 74

This lively straw-yellow sparkling chardonnay begins fresh and intense on the nose with notes of golden delicious apple and wildflowers. 24 months on the lees provides great structure and a well-rounded finish with hints of ripe fruit and toast.

### N/V Jaffelin Cremant De Bourgogne Brut, Burgundy, France 70

The predominance of Chardonnay in this easy-drinking but elegant traditional-method sparkler lends spine-tingling lemon flavors and a delicately chalky undertone. Matured for a minimum of 15 months, the pure-fruited sip has fine, persistent bubbles and a hint of smokiness on the finish.

### N/V Moet & Chandon "Imperial" Brut Champagne, Epernay, France 115

With a vibrant golden straw hue to it, and an alluring caress of fine bubbles, this sumptuous champagne presents elegant notes of brioche and white flowers on the nose, complimented with flavors of peach, pear and apple on the palate, and a subtle nuance of gooseberry to finish.

### N/V Veuve Clicquot Champagne, Reims, France 105

Pale lemon with fine bubbles; the nose is filled with aromas of apple, pear, toast and brioche; the palate is extra-dry and medium to full body with flavors that match the aromas.

### N/V Ruinart "Blanc de Blancs" Champagne, Reims, France 160

Estate grown and blended from 100% premier cru Chardonnay, Ruinart opens with intensity and warmth expressing notes of brioche and Meyer Lemon. The palate is supple with hints of honey and minerals finishing long and toasty.

### N/V Moet Chandon "Rose Imperial" Champagne, Epernay, France 175

A pink color with amber highlights, this lively and intense champagne has a bouquet that exudes wild strawberry, raspberry, and cherry, with floral nuances and a slight hint of pepper. On the palate, the wine shows a juicy intensity of strawberry, raspberry, and red currant, rounded out by the fleshiness and firmness of peach and the freshness of a subtle note of mint.

## WHITES

### 2021 Selbach "Incline" Riesling, Mosel, Germany 50

Vinified in stainless steel, with just a hint of residual sugar, this Riesling is fruity yet vibrant, with enough acidity to lend it clarity and precision. An intense, slate-driven minerality rounds each sip to provide a crisp finish.

### 2021 Cune "Monopole", Rioja, Spain 48

Made from the Viura varietal, this soft and fresh Spanish white is a pale-yellow color with subtle greenish hues. Aromas of apple, pear, white currants, and spring flowers are typical to grapes of the Rioja region. All stainless-steel fermentation helps keep this wine young and attractive, with a crisp and fruity aftertaste.

### 2020 Domaine Verset A&E Viognier Vin de France, Rhone Valley, France 52

White spring flowers on the nose, a little gooseberry and fresh pear on the palate. Well balanced and vivacious, with a subtle mineral line. This is a nicely measured style, medium- to full-bodied with good freshness and ample body and richness.

### 2022 Sauvion "Les Fondettes" Sancerre, Loire, France 74

This 100% Sauvignon Blanc features a bright and vibrant nose full of jasmine, acacia, and citrus aromas. Dry on the palate, it shows notes of grapefruit and lemon with a streak of minerality, pairing beautifully with shellfish and fresh cheeses.

### 2018 Heritage Sauvignon Blanc, Napa Valley, California 52

Full bouquet of citrus fruits, honeysuckle, and night blooming jasmine.  
A mineral rich and vibrant mouth feel compliment the finish.

### 2022 Craggy Range Sauvignon Blanc, Martinborough, New Zealand 68

This single vineyard Sauvignon offers rich lime, peach, and apple flavors, with a characteristic herbaceous quality.  
A pronounced minerality and vibrant mouth feel compliment the finish.

### 2021 Duckpond Pinot Gris, Willamette Valley, Oregon 46

A unique topaz grey in color, this Pinot Gris from Duckpond Vineyards displays aromas of honeydew melon, key lime, white tea, and geranium. Medium bodied, it offers interesting flavors of Meyer lemon, grapefruit, and pineapple in cream, with no discernable oak flavor. Understated and elegant, this is a satiny, vibrant Pinot Gris.

### 2021 Venetsanos Winery Assyrtiko, Santorini, Greece 110

Delicate, intense, and aromas of pear, white flowers, and citrus fruits. Pronounced aromas of bitter orange, with hints of mastic and fennel root. Rich, oily mouth, highly refreshing acidity, and a characteristic saltiness. Enjoyable long aftertaste.

### 2021 Michele Chiarlo "Le Marne" Gavi, Piedmont, Italy 52

This northern Italian white showcases aromas of citrus and minerals, while flavors of green apple and lime grace the palate.  
A fresh character is buoyed by crisp acidity and a lengthy finish.

### **2021 The Calling Chardonnay Dutton Ranch, Russian River Valley, California 72**

A classic Chardonnay blended from select Dutton Ranch vineyards in the Russian River Valley appellation. Barrel fermentation and sur lie aging have created a rich and smooth wine with subtle hints of oak, Meyer lemon & honeydew melon.

### **2021 Rombauer Chardonnay, Napa Valley, California 92**

Juicy peaches, pineapple and lime greet the nose, followed by vanilla and cedar. Tropical fruit and fig jam flood the lush, silky palate. Soft spice, vanilla and nectarines mark the lengthy finish with fresh, mouthwatering acidity.

### **2021 Stag's Leap "Karia" Chardonnay, Napa Valley, California 76**

This graceful Chardonnay has aromas of pear, white peach, and honeysuckle. Medium bodied and with a lovely texture, Stag's Leap strikes an elegant balance between ripe fruit, bright acidity, and an earthy minerality.

### **2021 Cakebread Cellars Chardonnay, Napa Valley, California 98**

A pretty, floral nose of fresh citrus, orange blossom, and white peach is just the beginning; flavors of peach, lemon zest, and lime grace the palate, with a perfect amount of oak to lend viscosity on the palate and a touch of creamy vanilla. This finish is clean, with a nice zing and lingering minerality.

### **2020 Jaffelin Meursault, Burgundy France 140**

From Meursault, Burgundy wine region, this Chardonnay is creamy with tropical fruit, lemon curd, smoky with flinty mineral and nutty flavors with a long, elegant, and vibrant finish. Complex and beautifully balanced.

### **2019 Kistler "Les Noisetiers" Chardonnay, Sonoma Coast, California 150**

Honeysuckle and stone fruit aromatics lead to a full bodied, juicy core, loaded with flavors of peach, apricots, and pineapple. Bristling with energy and a mouthwatering mineral backbone. This is a sexy, voluptuous Californian Chardonnay that sets the benchmark for all others. Rich and luxurious with layers of buttered red apple, butterscotch, lemon pudding flavors.

## **ROSES**

### **2022 La Spinetta Il Rose di Casanova, Tuscany, Italy 54**

This rose wine from La Spinetta is made with Sangiovese and Prugnolo Gentile grapes. It has a savory bouquet with notes of crushed rocks, white strawberries, and peach skins. The wine is soft and soothing, with a salty core of minerality and vibrant acidity. Hints of sour melon add to its juicy and energetic expression.

### **2022 Chateau Puech-Haut "Prestige" Rose, Languedoc, France 60**

Pale pink in color, it gives up fresh, crisp aromas of rose petal, white peach, and hints of melon. Medium-bodied, clean, and elegant with a hard-to-resist personality.

## 2020 Daou Rose, Paso Robles, California 52

This wine is remarkably fragrant, offering generous aromas of fresh peach, Bartlett pear and nectarine. The palate is delightfully silky, underlying a clean, fresh crispness delivering enticing flavors of mango, Crenshaw melon, lemon chiffon and tangerine.

## REDS

### 2021 Angels Ink Pinot Noir, Central Coast, California 54

This Pinot Noir is rich, round, and supple in texture. Fruit-forward with an integrated oak presence, the wine delights the palate with a crush of berry and a vanilla-backed juiciness that encompasses its overall personality.

### 2022 Willamette Valley Vineyards "Whole Cluster" Pinot Noir, Willamette, Oregon 68

This wine is ruby in color and opens with aromas of black cherry, raspberry, blackberry, and caramel. A fruit-forward and rich entry lead to flavors that mirror aromas with the addition of cranberry, dark chocolate, and baking spices that flow into a juicy mid-palate and soft, round finish accented by balancing acidity.

### 2021 Craggy Range Pinot Noir, Martinborough, New Zealand 86

This wine is crimson in color and opens with notes of tobacco, dark cherry, and earthy dried herbs, heightened by a subtle oak char. This 100% Pinot Noir is vibrant across the palate with svelte red fruits and velvety tannins finishing savory and dry.

### 2021 Willamette Valley Vineyards "Dijon Clone" Pinot Noir, Willamette, Oregon 72

The palate is juicy and round with a medium-bodied silky texture, flavors that mirror aromas of ripe red cherry, raspberry and cranberry accented by baking spice and red clay earth, with the addition of sweet barrel toast, and balancing acidity that retains the wine's vibrancy.

### 2019 Shea Wine Cellars "Estate" Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, Oregon 102

Shea Cellars produces a remarkable example of old-world technique and flavor in a new world setting. With just a touch of French oak, this pinot noir is supremely floral with notes of black tea and violet complimenting a palate rich with dark red fruit and white pepper.

### 2017 Albert Bichot Domaine du Pavillon Premier Cru Volnay, Bourgogne, France 180

The nose of this Volnay Premier Cru "Les Santenots" is delicately smoky and oaky with spicy notes. The appealing fruitiness of cherries and other red fruit is enhanced by mild spices such as cinnamon. This charming wine boasts beautiful structure and a remarkably full body.

### 2020 Sea Smoke "Southing" Pinot Noir, Sta. Rita Hills, California 165

Each year, the goal for Southing is to create the ideal marriage of complexity and elegance. The ever-changing nose of the Southing exhibits Montmorency cherry, sage, hibiscus, and subtle baking spices. The fine tannins and minerality are enhanced by the estate vineyard's characteristic cool climate acidity.

### 2016 Hofer Zweigelt, Weinland, Austria 50

This wine offers aromas of strawberry, cherry, and summer flowers. On the palate, it is medium-bodied, lively, and refreshing, with a long, pleasant finish. Serves as a great aperitif

### **2020 Kosta Browne Pinot Noir, Russian River Valley, California 225**

Ripe summer fruits are robust on the nose: blueberries, raspberries, and cranberries. Shaved nutmeg and burnt orange peel are also present, with touches of dried fruits and dried flowers. Intense and bold on the palate with bright acidity and a soothing mouthfeel. Focused and daring, the longer it rests on the palate, the more it intensifies.

### **2019 Cune "Crianza" Rioja, Rioja, Spain 42**

This blend of Tempranillo, Garnacha, and Mazuelo is a beautiful garnet color and offer surprisingly aromatic notes of red fruit and caramel. A combination of fermentation in stainless steel and American Oak creates a riper, fuller, more balanced wine, with red fruits intermingled with a creamy touch.

### **2013 Nita Priorat, Priorat, Spain 66**

Aromas of strawberry, licorice, and violets on the nose. Dry and medium-bodied on the palate, with bold flavors of black cherry and flint.

### **2017 Frescobaldi "CastelGiocondo" Brunello di Montalcino, Tuscany, Italy 130**

This wine expresses itself with clearly defined aromas of raspberry and pomegranate, enriched by elegant floral notes. Harmonious and well-defined on the palate with elegant tannin.

### **2018 Pio Cesare Barolo, Piedmont, Italy 132**

Aromas of spicy red cherries on a loamy underlay, together with savory twists of forest floor and walnut shell. Some orange rind, too. Full-bodied with very fine, firm, and silky tannins and lots of long, focused fruit and spice flavor.

### **2015 Marchesi di Barolo "Cannubi", Piedmont, Italy 155**

The color is ruby with garnet red hues. The aroma is intense, with clear scents of rose, vanilla, spices and roasted nuts and a vague hint of absinthe. It is a robust wine, with good body, full and elegant taste, soft and enveloping tannins. Pleasantly spicy and woody notes that merge together.

### **2020 Chateau Mont Redon Chateauneuf Du Pape, Rhone, France 90**

With an inky violet hue and an intense nose of red fruit and complex smokiness, this blend is tight and focused on the palate. Refreshingly tart and lemony, with a crunchy minerality and satiny texture.

### **2015 Chateau de Lidonne Cuvee Sublimis, Cotes de Bourg, France 68**

Bold, tannic, acidic, and dry, this red blend is balanced and well structured, with a bouquet bursting with black fruits. The finish is generous with tannin, allowing for a lingering and supple finish.

### **2016 Alpha Estate "Axia" Blend, Amyndeon, Greece 50**

A splendid purple red in color, this blend of Syrah and Xinomavro has a complex bouquet of pepper, vanilla, cloves, and ripe blackberries. A full mouthfeel showcases flavors of quince and vanilla, with a balanced acidity.

### **2018 Charles Smith "Boom Boom" Syrah, Columbia Valley, Washington 52**

A gorgeous opaque dark orchid color, the nose shows blueberry and crushed violet. On the palate, notes of cassis, plum jam, and black cherry dominate, with secondary notes of pepper and slate. Mouth filling and rich.

### **2019 Devil's Candy Red Blend, Napa Valley, California 80**

This blend of Zinfandel, Cabernet, Petite Syrah, Syrah and Charbono bursts from the glass with a pleasant aroma mixing freshly crushed blueberries, blackberries, black raspberries, dark chocolate, and violets. The massively rich, full-bodied palate features wonderfully complex and savory earth tones balanced with flavors of crushed black cherries, all lifted by a fantastic freshness. This beautiful wine is jam-packed with layers of black fruit and finishes long.

### **2021 Daou "Pessimist" Red Blend, Paso Robles, California 84**

An inky and dark aubergine in color, this blend of Petite Sirah, Zinfandel, Syrah and Lagrein showcases a plethora of fruit, such as blueberry, boysenberry, plum and strawberry. Smoky notes of truffle and roasted coffee are accompanied by floral accents of lavender and lilac, highlighted by underlying nuances of buttered toast, vanilla, and cool wintergreen.

### **2018 Blackbird Vineyards "Arise" Proprietary Blend, Napa Valley, California 130**

This succulent blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Cabernet Franc offers aromas of black currant, toasted clove, and freshly picked blackberries. Flavors of smoky pipe tobacco, nutty fig, and Bing cherry dominate, with a richly layered mid-palate that is complimented by soft texture, good density, and a long, lingering finish.

### **2019 Intrinsic Cabernet Sauvignon, Columbia Valley, Washington 56**

The flavors in this Cabernet Sauvignon are layered with tones of blueberry jam, pomegranate, and dark chocolate. The texture on the palate is rustic, yet silky, with a uniquely savory and inviting finish.

### **2019 Penfolds "Max's" Cabernet Sauvignon, South Australia, Australia 62**

The aromatic enticement is rewarded from the first sip. Ripe raspberry, bramble black currant and blood plum flesh out the fruit spectrum. Oak derived cassia bark and dark liquorice notes temper the gorgeous fruits. Taught, lingering tannins create texture and definition.

### **2019 Wente "Wetmore Vineyards" Cabernet Sauvignon, Livermore Valley, California 54**

Welcoming aromatics of dark cherry, plum, and blackberry lead in to this wine, coupled by comparable flavors and an accent of vanilla and cedar imparted from aging in oak barrels.

### **2017 Jordan Cabernet Sauvignon, Alexander Valley, California 110**

Aromas of black cherries, pomegranate, dried cranberries, and a hint of graphite channel classic Bordeaux. This Cabernet Sauvignon's red fruit flavors, silky palate and structure make it a wonderful wine for food. Its lovely, smooth texture coats the palate with layers of black cherries and a touch of cedar from French oak's fine tannins.

### **2021 Venge Vineyards "Silencieux" Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California 130**

A full bodied and dense vintage, this rich California Cabernet packs a nose full of dark cherry, blackberry, and vanilla bean. Robust flavors of cassis, blue fruits, baking spices, and blackberry cordial abound. With firm tannin and a velvety mouthfeel, this wine's lengthy and complex finish serves to reinforce its overall stellar quality.

### **2016 Neal Family Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon, Howell Mountain, California 155**

It leads with aromas of dried red fruit, black currant, well-tanned leather, and cassis. The tannins are fine and complement darker flavors of cocoa powder and espresso beans. You will find the finish lingers with the minerality of crushed rocks and natural acidity that forecasts its age-ability.
